Important information for households undertaking LFT Testing: -

We have had feedback that it is possible to produce a faint false positive result on the LFD test kits if the throat is swabbed within 30 minutes of food and drink being consumed. In order to read an accurate test result the reading must be taken 30 minutes after the start of the test.

As the weather is getting warmer can you please ensure that you apply sun cream to your child in the morning before they get to school and also provide them with a sun hat and plenty of water. If your child can apply his or her own sun cream please send to school the sun cream clearly marked with your child's name and class. Many thanks

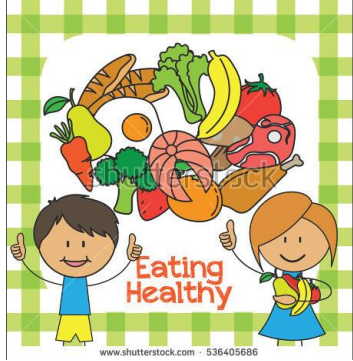
School Nursing service is available for support between 9am and 5pm
