### **Important information for households undertaking LFT Testing: -**

We have had feedback that it is possible to produce a faint false positive result on the LFD test kits if the throat is swabbed within 30 minutes of food and drink being consumed. In order to read an accurate test result the reading must be taken 30 minutes after the start of the test.

If you feel that you need support from the School Nurses please see details below:-

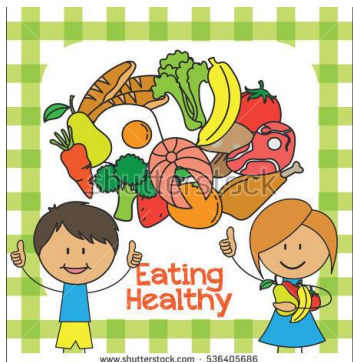
School Nursing service is available for support between 9am and 5pm
