Changes to afternoon pick up times from Monday 14th September

To ease the congestion in the afternoons at pick up time, children in Classes 3, 4, 5 and 6 who have siblings in Classes R, 1 and 2 will now leave school at 2.50 p.m

Older children together with their siblings in Class R will now exit together through the Reception gate at 2.50 p.m

Older children together with their siblings in Class 1 will now exit together through the side gate at 2.50 p.m

Older children together with their siblings in Class 2 will now exit together through the main entrance by the office at 2.50 p.m

Changes to morning drop off times for Classes 3 and 4 from Monday 14th September

As you can appreciate at this current time, procedures are having to be amended/changed all the time. As a result of this as from Monday 14th September, can you please ensure that children in classes 3 and 4 arrive at school at 8.30 a.m and come through the main entrance (by the office). A Teacher will be on the door where hand sanitiser will be provided.

If it is at all possible can you please stay in your cars until the actual drop off/pick up time to assist us with social distancing.
