With the end of term rapidly approaching we thought you would value a reminder of the events:-

**Wednesday 16th December Classes R, 1 and 2 Christmas dinner day, children to wear Christmas jumpers if they want to.**

**Thursday 17th December Classes 3, 4, 5 and 6 Christmas dinner day, children to wearing Christmas jumpers if they want to.**

**Covid** - In order to reduce the risk of any children having to self-isolate over the festive period we will be splitting into year groups bubbles from this Friday. This means that if a child gets a confirmed case of Covid it will be their class rather than the whole bubble who need to self-isolate.

**We will be open on Friday the 18<sup>th</sup> of December and school will end at the usual time.**

If your child develops any symptoms of Covid over the weekend of the 19<sup>th</sup> and 20<sup>th</sup> of December can you please email the school office to notify us and book a Covid test using the online booking site. We will check the school email on Monday the 21<sup>st</sup> between 9am and 10am. If we have not received any emails then we will notify you by email, this will hopefully give you the reassurance that you can celebrate Christmas without worrying your child may have to isolate. If any child or school based adult has developed symptoms and has been / needs to be tested we will notify you of this as well. As soon as we know their test result we will contact you (this is currently taking under 24 hours but can be up to three days). If the test is positive the period of self-isolation for your child will be 14 days from the 17<sup>th</sup> or 18<sup>th</sup> of December dependent on when symptoms began.

Santa will be visiting classes on the final day of term with social distancing and will be saying a goodbye to the children towards the end of the day. Unfortunately, parents will not be able to watch this but we will record it for you.

**On P.E days, can children in Classes 1 - 6 please come to school dressed in their P.E kits and also bring an extra pair of trainers in a separate bag.** As the weather is turning, can you please ensure that children also have warmer clothing i.e dark leggings/track suit bottoms and their school logo sweatshirt/school P.E hoodie. Can children please come to school wearing a warm/waterproof coat and/or hats, gloves and scarves.
